Chinese trains

The fastest train in the world will begin operating between Beijing and Shanghai by the end of September, according to the China Railway Corporation.

After several successful test runs, the Fuxing bullet train will operate regularly from September 21 with an average speed of 350km/h and a maximum of 400km/h.

A total of seven pairs of train will be launched that will make 14 return trips a day over a distance of 1318km separating the two cities.

The train will run 50km/h faster than the previous versions that ran at about 300km/h.

WHAT DO PEOPLE DO?

Many people clean their homes to welcome the Spring Festival. They put up the red posters with poetic verses on it to their doors, Chinese New Year pictures on their walls, and decorate their homes with red lanterns. It is also a time to reunite with relatives so many people visit their families at this time of the year.

In the evening of the Spring Festival Eve, many people set off fireworks and firecrackers, hoping to cast away any bad luck and bring forth good luck. Children often receive "luck" money. Many people wear new clothes and send Chinese New Year greetings to each other. Various activities such as beating drums and striking gongs, as well as dragon and lion dances, are all part of the Spring Festival festivities



Symbols

- Each new year year is represented by a [Zodiac animal sign](#). The red posters with poetic verses on it were initially a type of amulet, but now it simply means good fortune and joy. Various Chinese New Year symbols express different meanings. For example, an image of a fish symbolizes "having more than one needs every year". A firecracker symbolizes "good luck in the coming year". The festival lanterns symbolize "pursuing the bright and the



NEW YEAR GIFTS AND RED ENVELOPES

Like at Christmas in other countries, people exchange gifts during the Spring Festival. In rural areas and for older people the New Year gift giving tradition is still strong, but increasingly younger people prefer just to receive red envelopes (by hand or electronically).



Chinese New Year celebrations



The global celebrations are an explosion of light and sound - involving bell ringing, lighting firecrackers, and watching traditional lion dances.

Chinese families gather together for a reunion dinner on New Year's Eve, and clean their houses to sweep away bad fortune on New Year's Day.

Traditionally, kids would be given red envelopes stuffed with 'lucky money' and positive wishes on New Year's Day.

Some teens now have red envelope apps, so their relatives can transfer cash digitally.

NEW YEAR'S EVE DINNER

The New Year's Eve dinner is the most important dinner for the Chinese. Normally, this is the family reunion dinner, especially for those with family members away from home. In the New Year's Eve dinner, customarily, fish will be served. Dumplings are the most important dish in Northern China. These two dishes mean "prosperous." Other dishes are served depending on personal preference. The majority of the Chinese will gather together to eat New Year's Eve dinner at home instead of a restaurant.

DUMPLINGS

Dumplings are very popular in Northern China. It is one of the main dishes for New Year's Eve dinner. Conversely, very few people in Southern China serve dumplings in New Year's Eve dinner.

TANG YUAN

Tang Yuan is small ball made from glutinous rice flour. Glutinous rice flour is mixed with a small amount of water to form balls and is then cooked and served in boiling water. Tang Yuan can be either filled or unfilled. It is traditionally eaten during Yuan Xiao, or the Lantern Festival (the 15th of the first month of the traditional Chinese calendar).



LABA CONGEE

This is a mixture of rice, nuts, and beans cooked together. LaBa Congee is usually served at the LaBa festival, which is the 8th day of the last month of the year.



NEW YEAR CAKE

It is solid cake made with glutinous rice flour together with some sugar. New Year Cake is popular in Eastern China.

I love noodles because they taste very good. In this recipe, noodles are paired with chicken and colourful assortment of vegetables—including bok choy, celery and red bell pepper—in an oyster-flavoured sauce.



Spring rolls are a large variety of filled, rolled appetizers or **dim sum** found in East Asian and Southeast Asian cuisine. The name is a literal translation of the Chinese chūn juǎn (春卷 'spring roll').






Soohorang
